7km Sponsored Walk Wimbledon Common, 25th September 2010

Rules & Information

1. Only registered participants can take part in the walk - **you cannot register on the day.**
2. Please register as early as possible - **you must register by 10th September 2010.**
3. A sponsor pack will be sent out to all participants upon receipt of a registration form. The sponsor pack will contain full details of the day's agenda, a map of the walk, a stamped sponsor form, rules for the day, and a health and safety advice sheet.
4. All sponsor forms must have a **reunite** stamp to be valid.
5. Additional sponsor forms are available on request from **reunite**.
6. Please bring completed sponsor forms with you on the day as they will also be stamped on completion of the walk.
7. If you register for the walk but then find that you not able to participate, please let us know as soon as possible and return your sponsor form to **reunite**.
8. An adult named on the registration form must accompany anyone under the age of 16. Children are to be supervised at all times and remain the responsibility of their accompanying adult.
9. The **reunite** sponsored walk is not a race. Depending on your chosen pace, the 7km walk should take between 1 ½ - 3hours to complete. Please ensure you are fit and able to walk this distance. If in doubt please consult your doctor prior to registering.
10. Participants are to ensure that they have read the health and safety advice sheet.
11. A **reunite** t-shirt will only be provided to registered participants.
12. Participants are to ensure they wearing suitable clothing and footwear for the event.
13. There is a £2.50 registration fee for each adult participant. Registration for participants under the age of 16 is free. Your registration fees cover our administration costs. However, if we have to cancel the event, your registration fee will be returned.
14. If you are paying your registration fees by cheque/postal order, please put your name on the back of your cheque/postal order. Please do not send cash in the post.
15. Participants are asked to respect the fact that the walk is being held in a public place. Members of the public will also be using the area and respect is to be given to them at all times.
16. Participants must take responsibility for their litter and either carry it with them or put it in bins during the walk. Please ensure cigarettes are properly extinguished and ends are kept with you until they can be placed in bins as they pose an environmental hazard.
17. Dogs are to remain on leads at all times.
18. The route is not suitable for wheelchair users.
19. If you are bringing a pushchair, please be aware that the terrain is uneven in places.
20. The sponsored walk is a fundraising event and, by taking part in the walk, you are committing yourself to raising money for **reunite** International Child Abduction Centre.
21. You are not permitted to use any of the sponsorship money you raise to pay for your expenses.
22. All sponsorship money given to you must pass directly to **reunite** and must be received by **reunite** no later than **Friday October 22nd.**
23. If you do not pass all the money that you raise to **reunite** you may be committing a criminal offence.
24. **No alcohol is permitted during the event.**
25. Please ensure you are able to adhere to the above rules before registering for the event
